SUPPORT FOR YOU AND YOUR CHILD

It may be that you are struggling to communicate with your child, leading to frustration and anguish on both sides

Your child could be finding it difficult to join in and play and you are looking for ways to teach them how participate and engage.

Perhaps aspects of daily life such as eating, bath-time and sleeping are proving overwhelming and impacting on family life.

OUR SERVICES

PASS is available to children from early preschool years to primary age with autism or communication difficulties.

Following an initial assessment to establish your child's needs, our expert multi-disciplinary team will work specifically with you and your child (and your child's setting if required) to address areas of concern and deliver customized support.

The PASS team includes:

- 🧩 **Our Specialist Teachers** help you to understand your child's development and early educational approaches
- 🧩 **Our Speech and Language Therapists** provide help with the development of communication and interaction
- 🧩 **Our Occupational Therapist** helps address physical and sensory differences that impact on daily life.
- 🧩 **Our Special Learning Assistants (SLAs)** work directly with your child supervised by the Lead Teacher or Therapist

We use a range of assessment and teaching approaches* including the **SCERTS** educational model** (Social Communication, Emotional Regulation, Transactional Support) to assess and plan an individually tailored programme to support your child's development.

* We draw upon evidence based good practice in autism education including Hanen More Than Words, TEACCH, Picture Exchange Communication System (PECS), Intensive Interaction, ABA as well as the SCERTS educational model.
